

# Patch Script

v1.0

Type these script to improve the roaming efficiency. Users can follow these steps to optimal their applications.

**Step 1)** Select the “Administration → Configure & Manage ” item and type the following script on the “Command Script”.

**STARTUP=#!/bin/sh**


**STARTUP=**

**STARTUP=#Set the roaming scan time to 50ms**

**STARTUP=wrcsman "0x0032a700 50"**

**Step 2)** Click “Save” button to save all scripts.

**Step 3)** Reboot.
